Pawn Center Guidelines

Mobile Center:

Attacker Objective: Try to advance the mobile pawns and establish one or two passed

pawns in the center

Defender Objective: Try to check or blockade the enemy pawns.

Open Center:

Attacker Objective: Use pieces to conjure up weaknesses and then focus attack on those

weaknesses

Defender Objective: Wards off the opponent's attack while avoiding as much as possible

weaknesses

goes over to counter-attack or exploits opponent's excessively

bold play to win material

Closed Center:

Play on the flanks; Open up the game on the wings

Attacker Objective: Advance pawns until lines are opened up and breaches have been

made by an assault with the major pieces

Defender Objective: Defend passively by lying in wait, counter-attack, or sacrifice a piece

for an attack in the center.

Fixed Cente:

Attacker Objective: Focus on the center and station your pieces in the central field

Defender Objective: Drive the enemy pieces away from the center or exchange them off

Dynamic Center:

This is where the fate of the central pawns is not yet settled

Attacker Objective: Focus on the center and try to stabilize it or force one's opponent into

a pawn formation that he does not want to have.

Defender Objective: Focus on the center and try to stabilize it or force one's opponent

into a pawn formation that he does not want to have.
